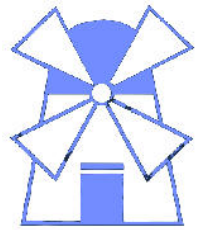

WELL DONE to class 9 who won Spike and the attendance trophy this week.

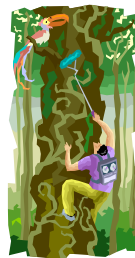


Year 1 love ICT and work very hard when in the ICT suite...

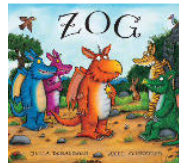
Class 8 will visit the garden centre in Thompson Road in the next few weeks to discover more about growing plants and beanstalks!
