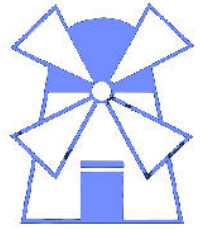




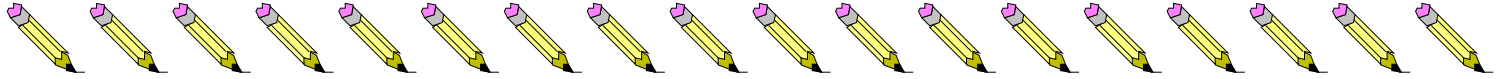

Dear parents,

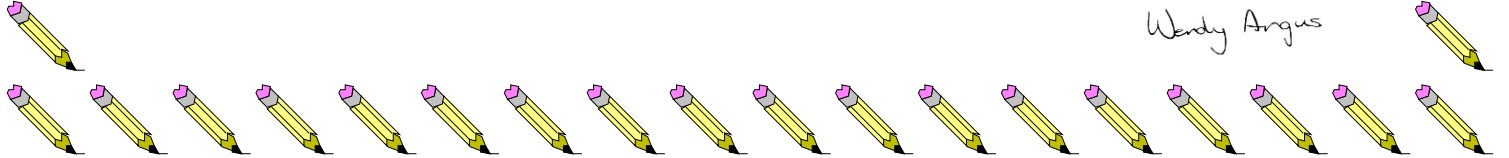

Year 1 walked along to the windmill on Monday morning. The weather was lovely and the children enjoyed seeing the windmill even though it wasn't possible to go into it.

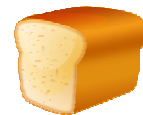
Well done to class 1 who have won our Spike attendance trophy for two consecutive weeks. As the children were told in assembly, it is a long time since we can remember this happening.

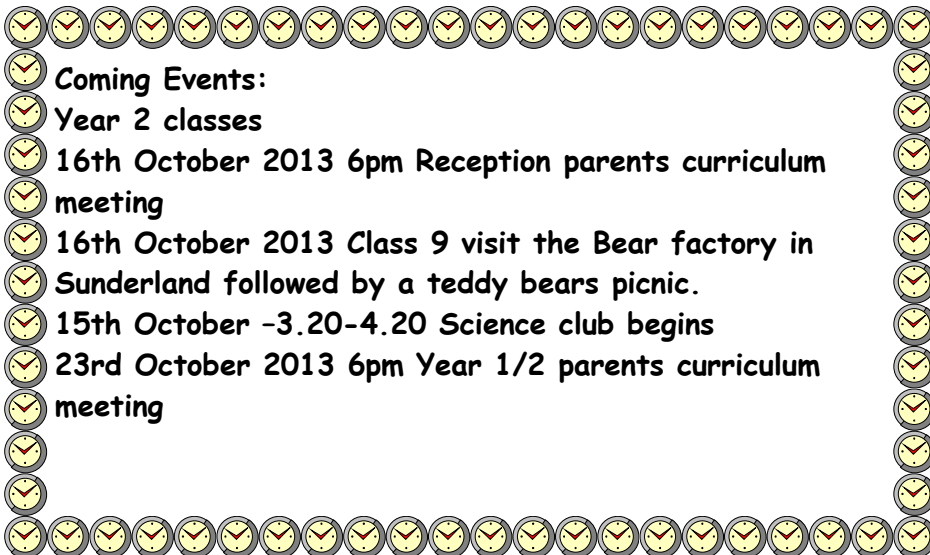


Class 8 will visit Newcastle airport on 9th October 2013.
