Points to Note

Sunderland Local Authority (LA) operates a co-ordinated admission scheme with other admission authorities within the city (i.e. RC & CE Aided and Free Schools and Academies) and with neighbouring LAs, including Durham, Gateshead and South Tyneside.

You can submit only one application for consideration, which should include preferences for Aided and Free schools, Academies and schools in other authorities. You may express up to three preferences. If any of your preferences are for a school other than a Sunderland Community or CE Controlled School, then we will contact the appropriate admission authority of that school to enable a decision to be made on your application. If you live in Sunderland we will notify you of this decision on the 'offer day' 18 April 2016.

If you live outside Sunderland but apply for schools within Sunderland, then your 'home' LA will notify you about the outcome of your application on their published date. In respect of admissions for September 2016, Sunderland LA will operate an 'equal preference' system. All Community, Voluntary Aided, Voluntary Controlled and Free Schools and Academies will consider all preferences equally. This means that all applications will be considered against the school/academy's admission criteria, no matter whether they are 1st, 2nd or 3rd preferences.

Therefore you need to consider very carefully which school/academy you wish to apply for and only list schools that you would like to be considered.

Voluntary Aided (VA) and Free Schools and Academies

You need to be aware that other admission authorities, e.g. Voluntary Aided (Roman Catholic & Church of England) and Free Schools and Academies have different admission policies and admission criteria to Community and CE Controlled schools in Sunderland, which decides how they will offer places. Details of their respective admission policies can be found in the booklet. You will need to consider the admission policy for any VA or Free school or Academy you express a preference for, in order to determine what system and criteria each individual school will use to consider your application.

Late applications

If you return your application form after **15 January 2016**, your application will be considered as 'late' and you should be aware that this **will** reduce your chance of gaining a place at the school that you want.

Address

When considering an application for a school place, only the address of the Parent/Legal Guardian/Foster Carer will be taken into account. You should be aware that each Admission Authority reserves the right to seek proof of address and to withdraw an offer of a place, if any inaccurate information or address is given on the application.

If you change your address after the submission of your form you must contact us immediately to let us know. We may ask you for proof of address if necessary.

Receipt of Application

Please make sure that you are given a receipt when you hand in your application form.

Advice

A telephone number for help and advice about the application process for all schools are listed on the front of this form. For advice on the admission policy of Community or CE Controlled schools in Sunderland you can ring the same number.

If you require advice and guidance about how the admission criteria/policy of a particular Voluntary Aided or Free school or Academy or school in a neighbouring LA relates to you then you will need to contact the respective school or LA directly.
