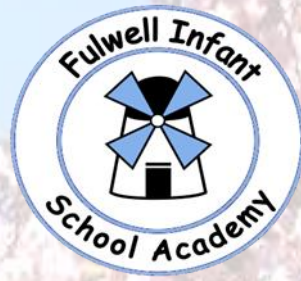

Dear parent,
