This year we are holding a Celebration Day for children on Wednesday 28th June 2023. We have organised for Chris and Rachel from 'Tiny Tweeties' to come and carry out a session with you and your child in school which will last for approximately 40 minutes.

There will also be the opportunity to share your child's Learning Journey with them. **We would ask only one adult attend** (if the weather is unsuitable for us to be outdoors we hope to still hold the sessions indoors) and would like to reassure you that children's Learning Journeys will come home to you in the Summer so that all the family can share their achievements, progress and experiences from across the year. Their most recent Learning Journey may go to Reception and if so, you will receive it during their Reception Year.

Tiny Tweeties are amazing and the children love their sessions so we hope you can enjoy the experience with your child! Please be aware the music session will be outdoors and we politely request you bring a blanket or rug to sit on.

You will be allocated a specific time slot to attend, unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate any changes due to constraints of numbers and attendance patterns. We are aware some families may not be able to make this and we will arrange for your child to be supported at the event by the Nursery Team. We are also unable to accommodate siblings at this event.
