The Quality of Education We aim to:

- To further develop children's mental fluency and rapid recall of number bonds through the Mastering Number programme. To ensure good long-term memory retention of key knowledge through the Daily Memory Jogger. To successfully implement the Financial Education Planning Framework throughout school so it is well embedded.
- To ensure all children achieve highly in reading, writing and phonics. In phonics ensure regular training opportunities and on-line opportunities are maximised by staff and ensuring the consistent delivery of our RWI programme throughout school to sustain exceptionally high standards.
- Ensure all children achieve highly (from their starting point) in reading. Focus on improved fluency and reading for pleasure, alongside a sustained focus on information retrieval skills.
- Improve the accuracy of spelling of key words in writing. In EYFS develop the independence in writing of children and their productivity. Standard of writing to be evident within creative writing and other subject areas, weekly in KS1.
- To embed securely and consistently the revised curricula through progressive differentiated delivery of subject knowledge and skills in response to accurate assessment, that impact on long term memory. Curricula provision to build on prior learning and reinforce meaningful links with other curricula being taught. (Focus on History, Science and Art)

 To focus on the delivery of key skills through a kinesthetic approach to learning ensuring that the high % of boys are supported in their early literacy skills including oracy and writing.

Personal Development, Behaviour and Attitudes We aim to:

- To build upon current outstanding practice and embed the Relationship and Sex Education (RSE) and health education policy in line with national guidelines.
- To further our support for the emotional well-being of children and their families with attachment/separation anxiety.
- Improve attendance to 95.5% by July 2024.
