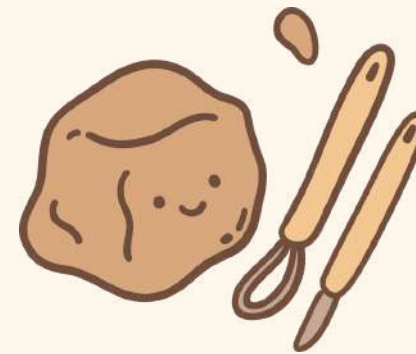
ANDY GOLDSWORTHY BARBARA HEPWORTH

Andy Goldsworthy is an artist who creates pictures and sculptures using natural resources.



Extends natural art with planned arrangements and simple 3D forms



Barbara Hepworth was an artist who made beautiful sculptures with smooth shapes and holes, inspired by nature and the world around her.



* Sticky Knowledge *

Andy Goldsworthy uses natural resources to create shape, colour, pattern (repeating) and texture in his artwork.

Andy Goldsworthy uses leaves, stones, sticks, ice and flowers in his artwork.

To plan and create his artwork Goldsworthy separates his materials into size [big, small], colour and shape [round, long]. and can build simple 3D sculptures and create textured rubbings.

Natural materials can be used to make outdoor art with different shapes/colour/pattern and texture

Primary colours

WORDS TO REMEMBER

sculpture

A piece of art that is made in 3D.

natural

Something that comes from nature, like wood, stone, or leaves.

materials

The things used to make something, such as clay, wood, metal or paper.

size

How big or small something is.

colour

What something looks like, such as red, blue, green or yellow.

texture

How something feels when you touch it - smooth, rough, or soft.

shape

The outline of something, like a circle, square or triangle.
