A **human feature** is something on Earth's surface that has been created, built or altered by humans.

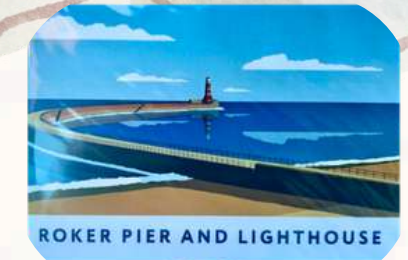
