HOW ARE JAMAICA AND GREAT BRITAIN SIMILAR/DIFFERENT?

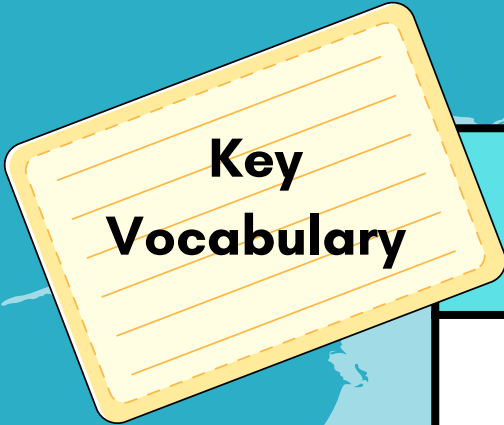
-   Jamaica and Great Britain are both islands.
-   Both countries speak English.
-  Jamaica is a humid, tropical, warm Caribbean island.
-  Great Britain has distinct seasons with colder temperatures.



The capital city of Jamaica is **Kingston**.

The capital city of England is **London**.

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population	The total number of people living in a country, city, or other area.
hemisphere	A hemisphere is formed by dividing the earth into the Northern and Southern Hemispheres at the equator, or into the Eastern and Western Hemispheres at a meridian.
pollution	Poisons, wastes, or other materials that pollute.
environment	Everything that surrounds a particular type of living thing and affects its growth and health.
landmark	A point in a landscape that is used as a reference or marks a boundary.
climate	The usual weather conditions in a place.
Island	An area of land smaller than a continent and surrounded by water on all sides.
